April 1st 2021 marks the 35th anniversary of Beavers launching in the UK and that is as good a reason as any to celebrate!

We are having 2 badges to mark the occasion. The first is a badge that celebrates the first 35 years of Beaver Scouting in Hampshire, featuring some of the exciting adventures we have been on together. The second is a challenge badge linked to other events happening throughout the next year. Both are approved to wear on uniform.

How to buy...

The badges are $\pounds 1$ each or $\pounds 1.80$ for both if you buy them together as a set. They can be bought at shop.bvr.org.uk where you can also buy some of our older badges at the same time. Postage is $\pounds 3$ per order or you can collect from Eastleigh. You can pay by cheque or bank transfer with card payment coming soon.

Hampshire Beavers - 35th Birthday of Beavers Celebration Badge



This badge can be worn by Hampshire Beavers, Leaders and Young Leaders working with Beavers as it has been approved as an occasional badge.

There are no requirements for this badge, it can be worn from launch on 1st April 2021.

Hampshire Beavers - 35th Birthday of Beavers Challenge Badge



This badge is a celebration of the events that happen throughout the year. To earn this badge you have to complete a number of tasks around these occasions either individually or with your colony.

The events are broken into blocks of 2 months starting with April & May. You need to do a minimum of **3** tasks each 2 months. Of course you can do more as they link together well!

You need to complete a minimum of **3** pairs of months to earn the badges, though we'd encourage you to try all 6 if you can!

Of course we understand this is coming after a crazy year. If you have Beavers leaving in this time they can earn the badge sooner. If you already do something similar to one of the tasks then you can count that too, I'll make sure the Badge Police look the other way.

Ultimately this badge is designed to be a challenge, it shouldn't be earned too quickly but should be attainable for all who put in the effort.
